Storm Policy

Per the Madaket Marine Hurricane Plan, our order of priority when preparing for a storm is:

- 1) Protect human life
- 2) Seek to prevent or minimize personal injury
- 3) Reduce the exposure of property damage
- 4) Minimize damage to property that cannot be relocated
- 5) Seek to restore normal operations as quickly as possible



Please note that as a vessel owner it is your responsibility to maintain awareness of approaching storms and to prepare accordingly. Once a storm is predicted a decision must be made in a timely manner on whether or not to pull the boat. Owners must contact the yard at their earliest convenience as these hauls will be done on a first come, first serve basis. There is often a short window of opportunity for our staff to safely access and haul vessels and when conditions worsen we will not place any team member in harm's way. In the case of last September's near miss with Hurricane Earl we were able to successfully haul out over 150 boats in a very short amount of time. After a storm, we make every effort to put the boats back in the water in a quick and efficient manner; your patience is greatly appreciated. Many insurance companies will pay for

storm hauls, please check with yours to be sure of your coverage.

Safety Requirement Update

During a recent U.S. Coast Guard vessel inspection we learned that the Massachusetts boating law has changed for boats over 26'. If your boat is 26' or longer, you are required to have an efficient bell on board. It can be either handheld or mounted and must be in addition to any whistles or air horns you already have.
