Environmental Corner

Madaket Marine has recently installed a boat wash bay with a water recycling system called Water Maze ECI-300. This water treatment system prevents contaminants from entering our water ways as we wash boats. The way it works is as we are pressure washing the boats water goes into a newly installed drain which has filters to catch any debris. From there the water goes into a underground concrete tank then gets pumped up into the water maze which cleans the water then runs it back through to the pressure washer. The total estimated water savings over the course of a season is approximately 10,000 gallons. To learn more about the Water Maze system visit www.wmaze.com
