**National Saltwater Angler Registry**

**Register 2010**

A new federal law requires most Massachusetts saltwater fishermen to sign up with the National Saltwater Angler Registry. Registration is quick, easy and FREE in 2010.

Starting in 2010 if you are over the age of 16 you will need to register to fish in Massachusetts Saltwater. In 2011 you will be required to purchase a state Recreational Saltwater Permit. The environmental officer and the U. S. Coast Guard will be enforcing this law. To read more about this or to register see the links at the bottom of this newsletter.
